**Our Strengths**(\*Please note, these scores are tentative. Final scores will be available sometime in October. When the final scores are out, this will be updated to reflect new scores.)

- ~CIE has a School Performance Score (SPS) 77, which is a B.
- ~The ELA Whole School Index Score went from 79.8 (2018) to 86.0 (2019).
- ~The Math Whole School Index Score for 2019 is a 79.1.
- ~Positive Behavior Support continues to improve our school climate.
- ~Community/Parent Support always contributes to CIE's strengths. Parent Family Events (PFE) continue to be well attended.
- ~Staff Professional Development contributes to CIE's strengths.

### Our Goals

- ~Kindergarten-Third Grade students will increase reading achievement by increasing the percentage of students At or Above Benchmark on DIBELS Next by 5% from Fall 2019 to Spring 2020.
- ~In Spring 2019 to 2020 the percent of students achieving Mastery or Above on the ELA and Math Assessment Index, LEAP 2025: ELA: Increase by 4 Index points from 86 to 90 and Math: Increase by 7 Index points from 79.1 to 86.1
- ~In Spring 2019 to 2020 the students in the subgroup, "Students With Disabilities" for the Whole School will increase the Index on LEAP 2025 as follows: ELA: Increase by 5 Index points from 47 to 52 and Math: Increase by 32 Index points from 18 to 50.
