- ~CIE has a School Performance Score (SPS) 83.8, which is a B.
- ~The ELA score went from 73 to 96.7, increasing by 23.8 points.
- ~The math score increased to 87.3%.
- ~Positive Behavior Support continues to improve our school climate.
- ~Community/Parent Support always contributes to CIE's strengths. Parent Family Events (PFE) continue to be well attended.
- ~Professional Development contributes to CIE's strengths.

### Our Goals

- ~Kindergarten-Third Grade students will increase reading achievement by increasing the percentage of students AT or Above Benchmark on DIBELS Next by 15% from Fall 2017 to Spring 2018.
- ~From Spring 2017 to Spring 2018 students in third grade will increase the percentage of students achieving Mastery or Above by 10% in the Major Content Subclaim in Math on LEAP 2025.
- ~From Spring 2017 to Spring 2018 the students in the subgroup, Students with Disabilities for the Whole School will increase their Assessment Index score by at least 15 points on LEAP 2025.
